A Brief History of Martin Autopark

Martin Chevrolet Company was founded in 1941 by B. B. Martin. The original dealership building was located on Highway 59 (then called Highway 35) near the southeast corner of its intersection with Highway 321. In 1952, a fire which started in a neighboring business spread to Martin Chevrolet and completely destroyed the building. A new facility at 516 S. Washington was completed in 1954, and is still in use today.

In 1958, the Buick franchise was added and the company was renamed Martin Chevrolet-Buick, Inc. In 1977, the Mack Truck franchise was added (now the Mack truck dealership is a separate company called Performance Truck). The Pontiac, Oldsmobile and GMC franchises were added in 1992, and our name became Martin Autopark. A beautiful new showroom building was constructed in 1994, and is dedicated to the memory of B. B. Martin, our founder. Two additional stores were added: Bounds Autoplex in Livingston (1997) and Martin Chrysler in Cleveland (2005).


























C/K3500 Work-Ready Truck: Dump Truck



C/K3500 Work-Ready Truck: Utility Truck









