early musical training was in Texas and, in composition, he is self-taught. Later,

he studied the piano under Godowsky in Vienna.

Guion is probably best known from his association with "Home on the Range," the popular concert version being his work. He has also composed a great number of songs, and his witty transcriptions of such melodies as "Turkey in the Straw," "Arkansas Traveler," and "Sheep and Goats," have long been favorites.

"Texas," composed of fourteen sections, is a "tonescape" presenting, as it does, musical descriptions and impressions of almost every section of the Lone Star State:

II. Square Dance (San Angelo, West Texas)
